Job Purpose: This position is responsible to plan, implement, and evaluate nutritional care and medical nutrition therapy for residents with a variety of health conditions and to provide technical assistance and recommendations concerning dietary and medical nutrition.

Essential Job Functions to include:

- Consult with physicians and other health care personnel to determine nutritional needs and diet restrictions of residents.
- Formulate menus for therapeutic diets based on medical and physical condition of residents and integrate residents' menus with institutional menus.
- Inspect meals served for conformance to prescribed diets and for standards of palatability and appearance.
- Responsible to make sure the initial comprehensive, change of condition and quarterly nutrition assessment process is planned and completed within the time requirements specified by law and best practice.
- Collaborate with departments to develop and implement facility policies and procedures insuring line employees, nurses, physicians and other ancillary staff are apprised of residents' nutrition requirements.
- In conjunction with the Director of Food Services, develop and implement the resident menu including modified extensions, recipe conversions and production requirements.
- Write and implement discharge plans to residents as appropriate.
- Other related duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required:

- Bachelor's degree from a recognized college or university with course work which meets the academic requirements for a dietitian as specified by the American Dietetic Association and four years of experience as a registered dietitian in a hospital or long term care environment or any combination of education and experience which demonstrates possession of the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
- Registration as a Registered Dietitian approved by the American Dietetic Association.
- Knowledge of the principles and practices of nutrition and dietetics and of institutional diet management including food values and costs.
- Knowledge of the application of federal and state dietetic and nutrition standards.
- Knowledge of special nutritional requirements as they pertain to a variety of medical conditions and resident needs.
- Ability to retain confidential information.
